## CONFIDENTIAL ADVISORS TU DELFT

Did you know the TU Delft has a team of confidential advisors? If you are confronted with undesirable behaviour or suspect a breach of integrity at TU Delft, you can go to one of the confidential advisors for support and advice. The confidential advisor will listen to your story and help you explore the steps you can take. All confidential advisors have a strict duty of confidentiality. If necessary, they can refer you to a university social worker, a student psychologist, HR or a legal advisor.

The team consists of six internal confidential advisors and one external confidential advisor. Internal confidential advisors are employed at the university, while the external confidential advisor is not employed at TU Delft. All confidential advisors can provide advice to anyone at the TU Delft. This means that it is up to you to choose to whom you want to turn, depending on your question and preferences.

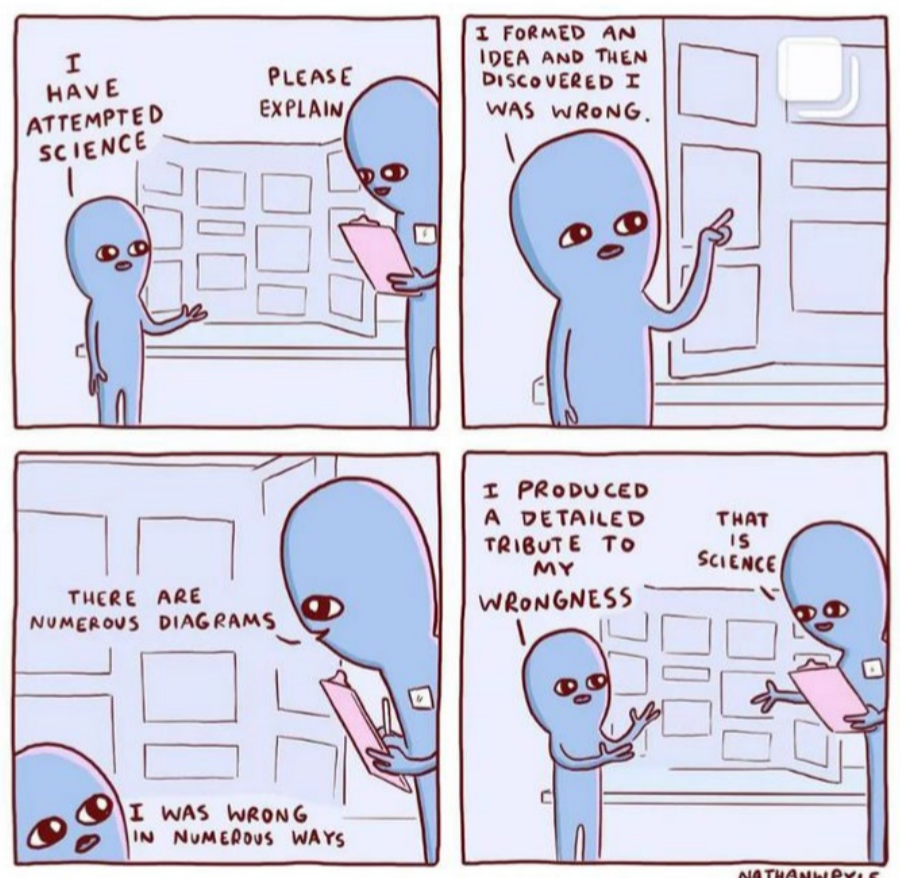
