EXPERTISE

His research includes a wide range of transportation issues related to passenger transport. His primary expertise is travel behaviour on a strategic level (trip generation, destination and mode choice) in relation to service level characteristics of transport networks, design of public transport networks, characteristics of long distance travel, and the implications of travel time budgets for assessing time savings. Examples of studies are a detailed description of leisure travel in the Netherlands; modal shift analyses between public transport and car; modal choice analysis in school travel by Dutch and Flemish pupils; impact of improving bicycle accessibility to train stations on train and car use; reviewing evaluated interventions in bicycle infrastructure and comparing the evaluation of one large bicycle project with PT-project evaluations; cost-benefit analysis of railway closures; and assessing the effects of suspending subsidies for public transport operation.
