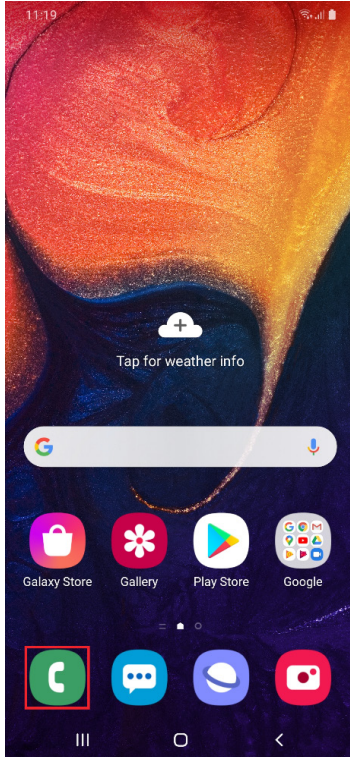
# Enable WiFi calling on Android 9 on a Samsung phone.

## Before you begin

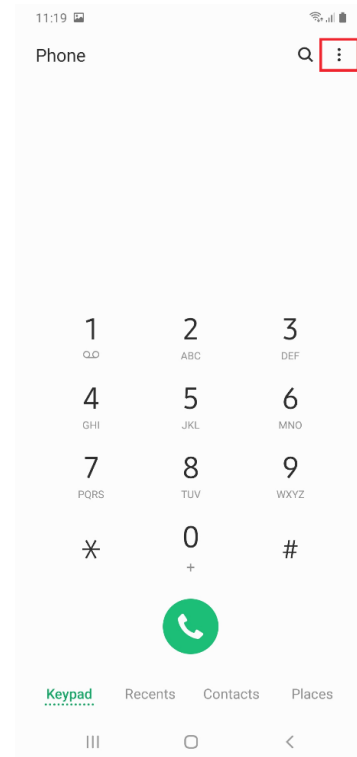

## Enabling WiFi calling on your Samsung Android phone

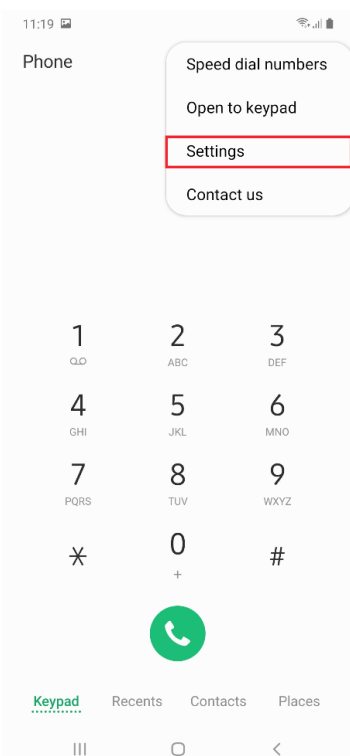
Step 1. Go to the **Phone** app.



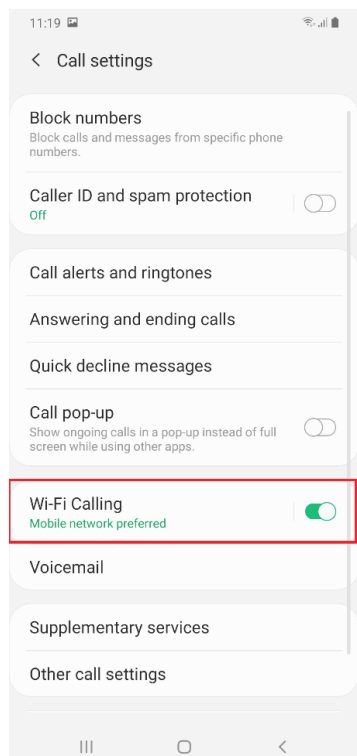
Step 2. Tap on the **Menu** icon (3 dots)



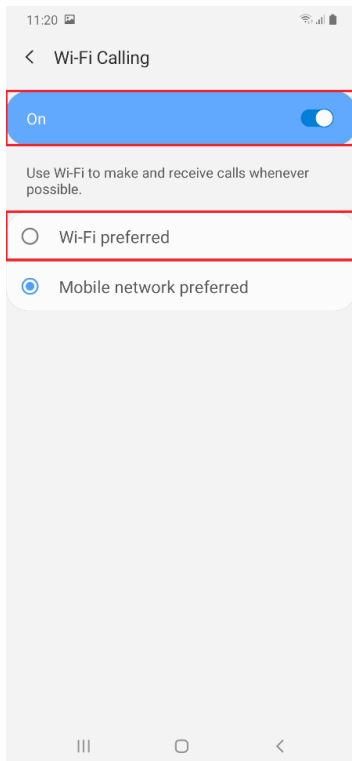
Step 3. Tap on **Settings**.



Step 4. Tap on **Wi-Fi calling**.



Step 5: If not enabled: enable Wi-Fi calling by setting it to **on**. Then, select **Wi-Fi preferred**.



Step 6: You are now able to make and receive calls over Wi-Fi.
