# Enable WiFi calling on iOS 13

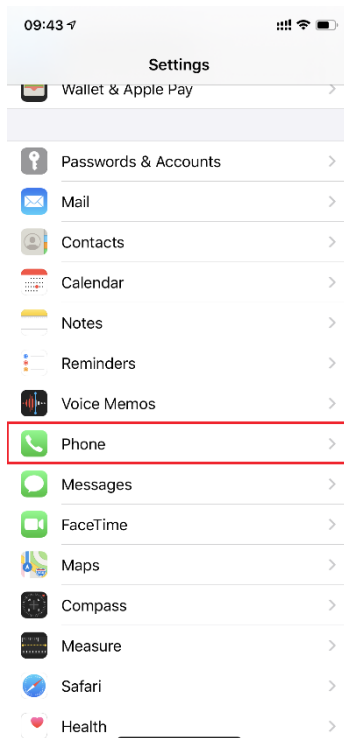
Use this manual to enable calling via WiFi on your iPhone.

## Before you begin

Description of the steps that have to be taken

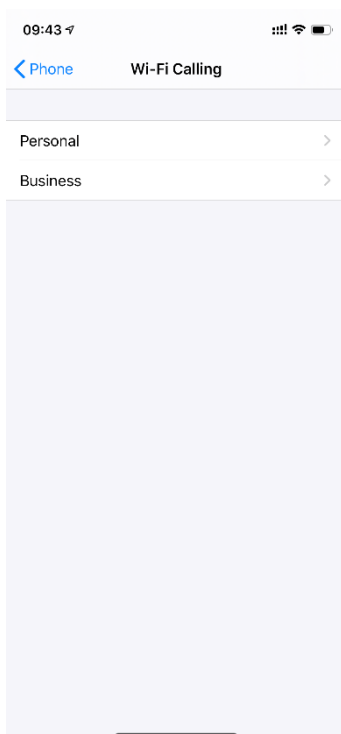
Step 1. Go to the **Settings** app. Scroll down and tap on **Phone**.



Step 2. Tap on **Wi-Fi Calling**.



Step 3. Select the data plan for which you want to enable WiFi calling (**personal** or **business**).



Step 4. Enable the setting **Wi-Fi calling on This iPhone**. You are now ready to make and receive calls over WiFi.
