

# Disclaimer Incoming exchange students

## Semester 2, 2021-2022

By accepting your offer of admission at TU Delft:

- You confirm you have read and understood the information provided below.
- You agree to bear any financial, health and academic risks associated with your exchange.

### Before your arrival:

- Your home university may not have decided whether they will allow student mobility in the second semester 2022. Your exchange could be cancelled by your home university. Thus, we recommend that you have a plan B (i.e. Alternative plans for a semester at your home university).
- If you decide to cancel the application for TU Delft's housing service before you gain access to the housing platform, we will refund the (paid) housing cost of € 272,50. If you would like to obtain a refund before access, please send an email to [contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl](mailto:contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl).
- If you require a Residence Permit for Study in the Netherlands, and you wish to cancel your visa application before TU Delft starts your actual application in the IND portal, we will refund your visa application fee of €192. If you would like to obtain the refund before the official application, please send an email to [contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl](mailto:contactcentre-esa@tudelft.nl).
- No fees will be refunded after gaining access to the housing and IND portals.

### Travelling to TU Delft:

- Travel to the Netherlands/TU Delft will be, as usual, dependent on any restrictions and regulations in place by the [Dutch Government](#). The Dutch authorities may impose travel restrictions or lockdown measures again.
- You may have to go into a period of quarantine. More information about when to go into self-isolation and how this works can be found on the Dutch Government [website](#). Additional costs associated with quarantine measures cannot be reclaimed from TU Delft.

### Studying at TU Delft:

- Today, no one can say with certainty which Covid-19 restrictions will continue to be necessary in the second semester and how the educational situation will develop and what it will look like (hybrid, online, on campus). It cannot be ruled out that the circumstances of the pandemic may require TU Delft to adapt teaching/ learning /assessment when necessary, by remote means. This may limit personal interaction with lecturers and fellow students and may partially eliminate the intercultural experience of your exchange. Lab access could be restricted due to social distancing rules and other possible measures in the case of a resurgence of infections. - Due to possible restrictions on physical distance and group size there may be fewer and smaller events than usual.
- Social distancing and strict hygiene rules / recommendations may be in place on campus as well as in student housing facilities, see [here](#) for more information.
- Rental contracts for student housing via TU Delft are for full semesters and have a fixed period (for the Second semester, from February until August). In case of an unscheduled early departure, you will nonetheless be liable for rent for the complete rental period contract. However, students may try to find another student who is willing to take over their housing contract.
- Student housing is at an all-time low, in and around Delft. This is also a national problem for the Netherlands. You will find it difficult to find a room whether it be privately or via our housing department. Should you not be able to find a room before your arrival then we advise you not to come to TU Delft for an exchange programme.
- Your physical presence at TU Delft is required regardless of the number of courses delivered online.
