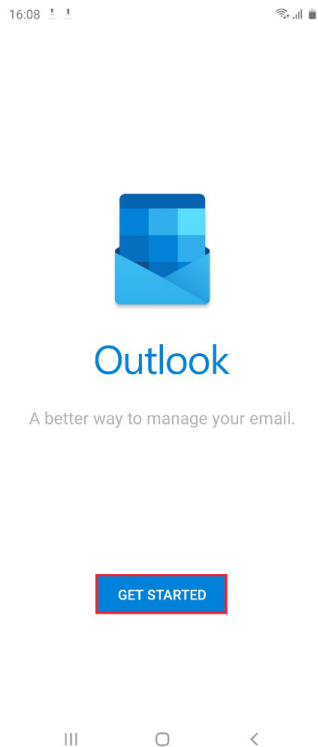
Using the Outlook app on a Samsung phone with Android 9

Before you begin

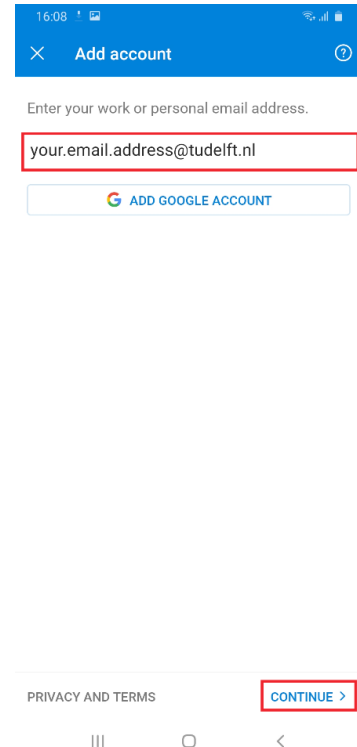

Connecting your Android 9 Samsung phone to your mailbox using Outlook

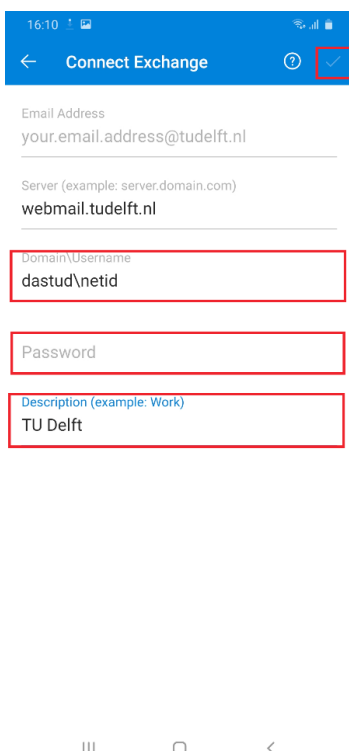
Step 1. Install the **Outlook** app, open the app and tap **Get started**.



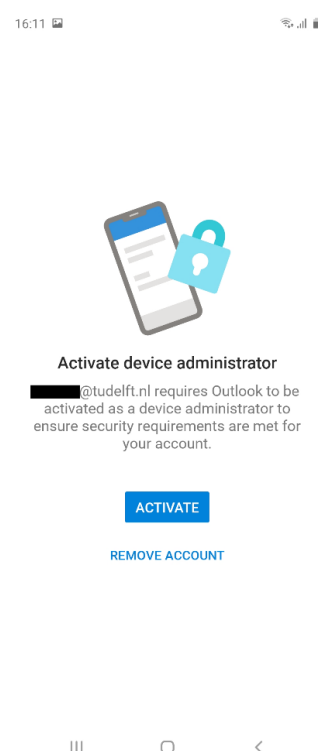
Step 2. Enter your TU Delft email address and tap continue.



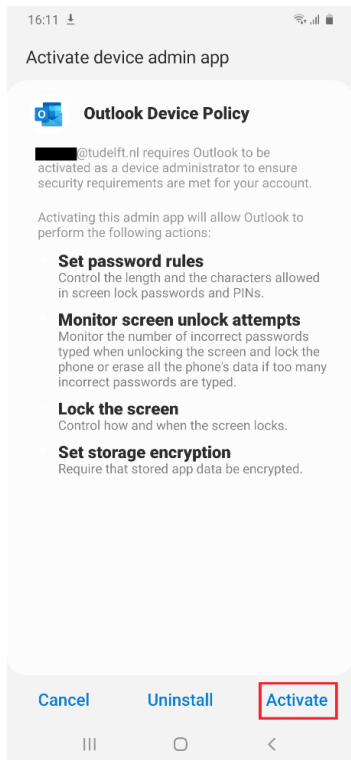
Step 3. Enter the Domain\Username: **dastud\yournetid** and your password. Choose a description, then tap the check mark. Tap **Activate**



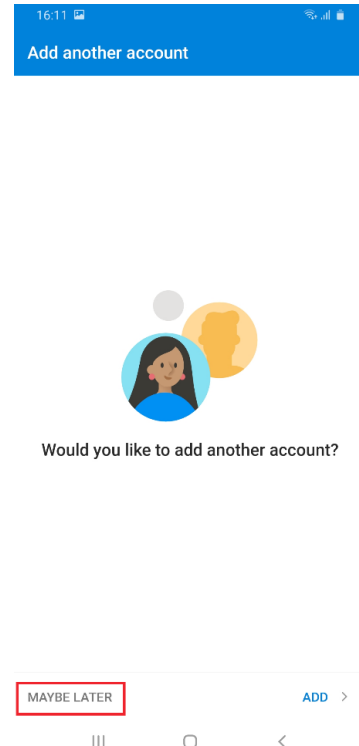
Step 4. Tap **Activate**.



Step 5. Tap **Activate** in the Activate this device app.



Step 6. Tap **Maybe Later** for now.



Step 7. Tap **Skip**. Your account will now sync, this may take some time.
