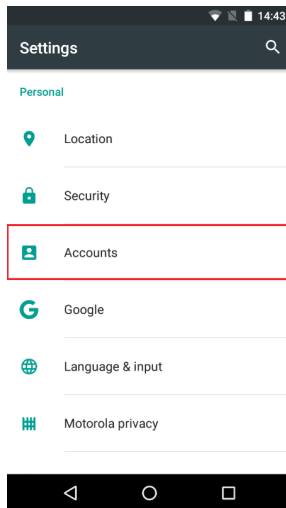
Adding a functional mailbox to Android

Before you begin

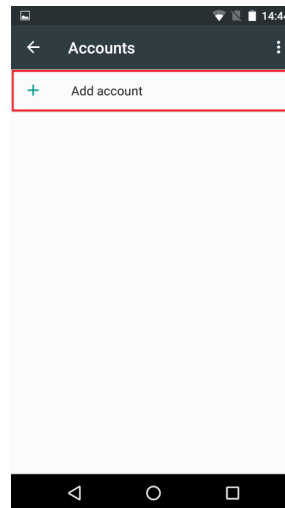

In the event you have a different configuration or version of Android 6.0 and you have problems connecting, we advise you to contact your nearest Service Desk, Student IT Desk (SID) or Workstation services (WPS).

Connecting your Android phone or Android tablet to your functional mailbox

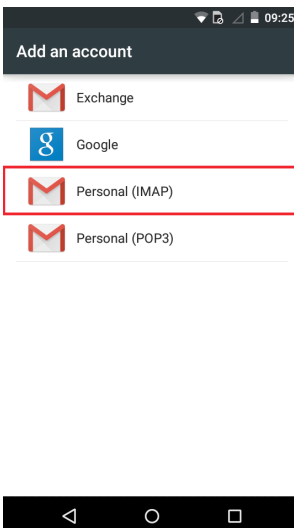
Go to the **Settings** menu (Menu button > Settings or All Programs > Settings. Tap **Accounts**.



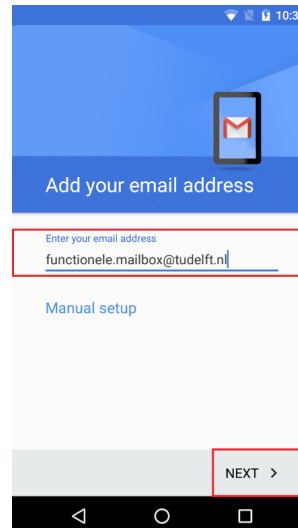
2. Tap **Add account**.



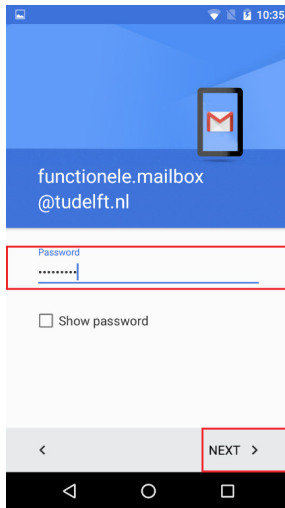
3. Tap **Personal (IMAP)**.



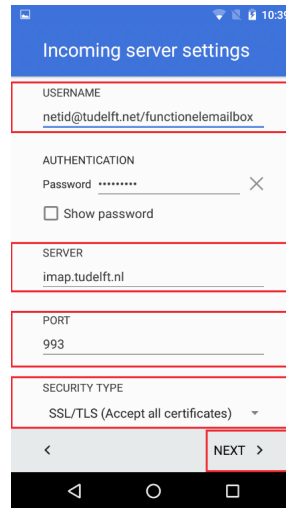
4. Enter the **TU Delft functional e-mail address** and tap **Next**.



5. Enter your **NetID** password and tap **Next**.



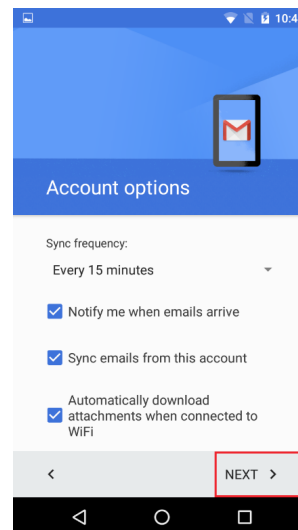
6. For username enter **NetID@tudelft.net/functionalmailbox** (without @tudelft.nl). Change server into **imap.tudelft.nl**, set port to **993**, change the security type to **SSL/TLS (accept all certificates)** and tap **NEXT**.



7. For **smtp server** enter **smtp-a.tudelft.nl**. Change **port** to **465**, change the **security type** to **SSL/TLS (accept all certificates)**. Enable **require sign-in**. Set the username to **NetID@tudelft.net**. Enter your **NetID password**. Tap **Next**.



8. Optionally change your account and synchronization settings and/or tap **Next**.



9. Optionally, enter a recognizable account name and tap **next** to finish.
