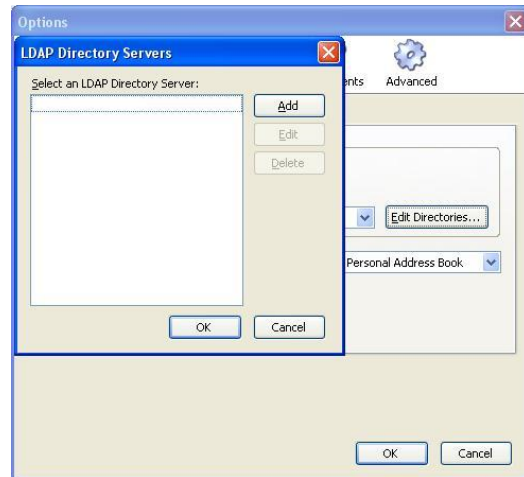
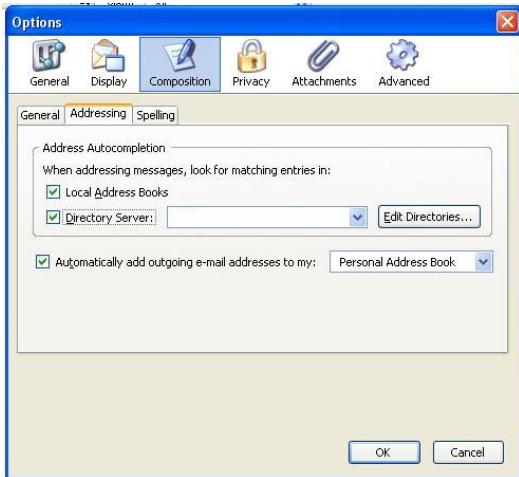

1 Introduction

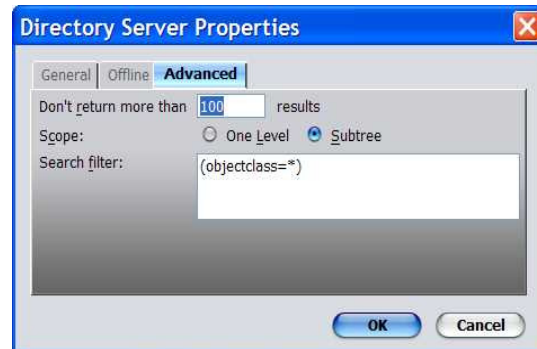
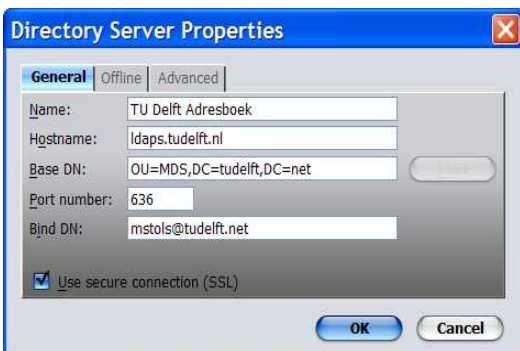
Follow the next steps to set the TU address book in Thunderbird:

1. Select in the **Tools** menu: **Options**.
2. Click on **Composition**
3. Select the tab **Addressing**
4. Tick **Directory server** and click on **Edit directories:**
5. Click **Add**



6. Fill in the next details. Fill in: <your netid>@tudelft.net at the option **Bind DN**.
(**Please note:** .net)

7. You can set on the tab **Advanced** the searchresults. 100 results are enough.



8. When you fill in the first address, the system ask for your password. Fill in your NetID password. When you select the tick, the system will not ask for your password the next time.

9. Offline address book doesn't work in Thunderbird. It seems to be a bug in Thunderbird.



Please note: if this pop up appears again, it is possible that the Bind DN is not correct or there is something wrong with your account.
