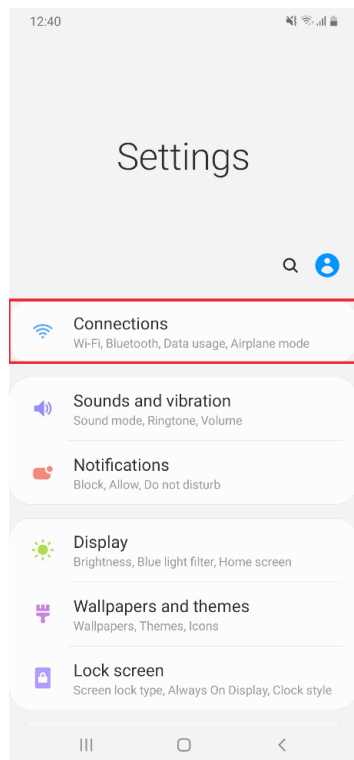
Connecting to the 'eduroam' network on Android 9 on a Samsung phone.

Before you begin

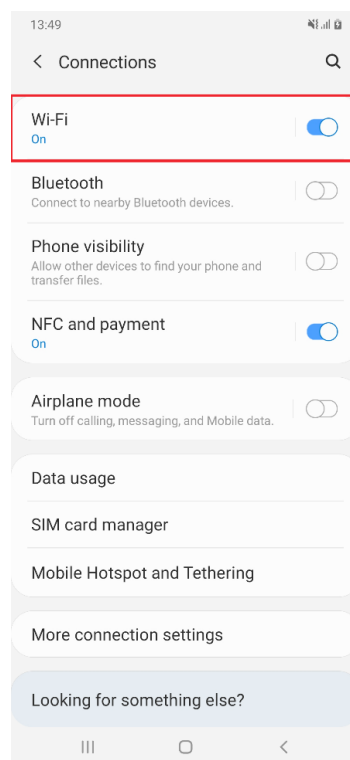
The following instructions are supported by TU Delft and have been tested to be working. We are offering this manual to you as an extra service. In the event you have a different configuration or version of Android than 9 or lower or a different type of phone than Samsung, and you have problems connecting, we advise you to contact your nearest Service Desk, Student IT Desk (SID) or Workplace services (WPS).

Connecting your Samsung phone to eduroam

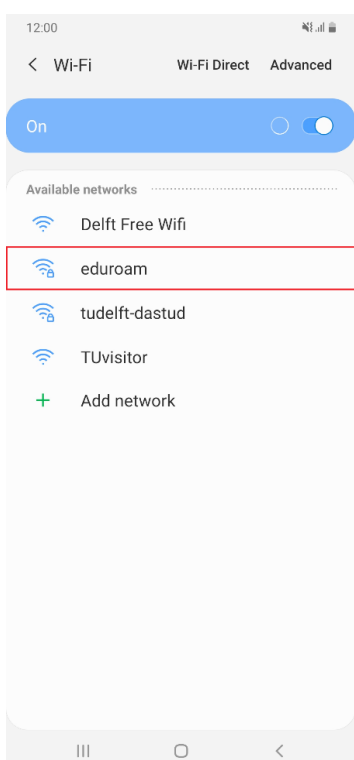
Step 1. Go to the **Settings** app and tap **Connections**.



Step 2. Tap on **Wi-Fi**.



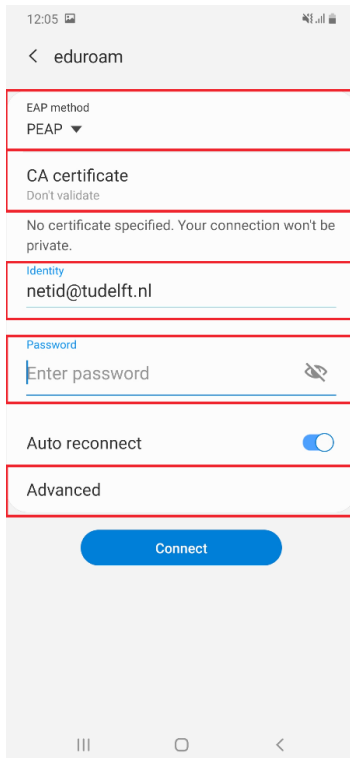
Step 3. Tap on **eduroam**.



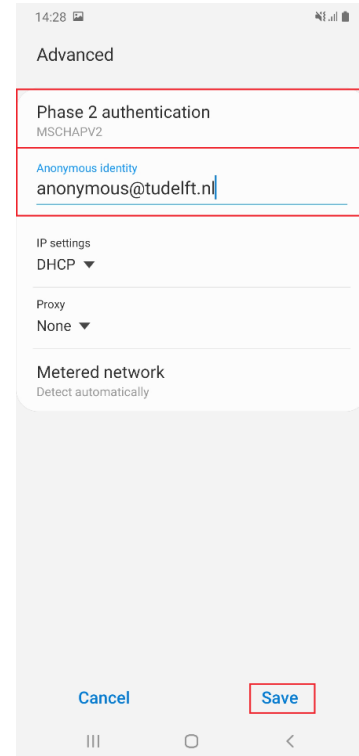
Step 4. Enter the following details:

- Set the EAP method to **PEAP**
- Set the CA certificate to **Don't validate**
- Enter your identity: **your NetID with @tudelft.nl**
(note: this is **not** your e-mail address!)
- Enter your **NetID password**

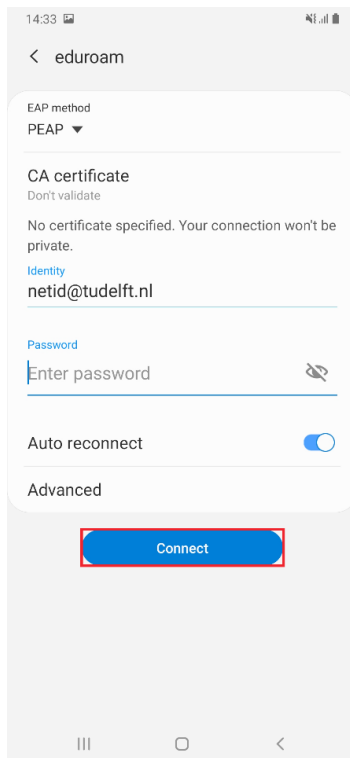
Then, press **Advanced**



Step 5. Set Phase 2 authentication to **MSCHAPV2**. Enter the anonymous identity **anonymous@tudelft.nl**, and press save.



Step 6. Press **Connect**.



Step 7. You are now able to use the eduroam network if you are in range.
