Setting up a event network for TU Delft events

Discription

If you wish to organise a conference at TU Delft you can use the Event Network. This network is given a recognisable name for the visitors to the event. Visitors login on this network using a generic password.

Applying

If you are organising an event at TU Delft and wish to use the TU Delft Event network, please contact the Service Desk at least **one working week** in advance. The Service Desk requires the following information to create the application:

- Your name
- Start and end date of the event
- Location
- Recognizable name for the network
- Contact information of the event organiser

You should contact the Service Desk at least **one working week** in advance. The network services will go live **one day earlier**, so as to give you time to test them.

You will receive a password that can be used for all visitors to the event.

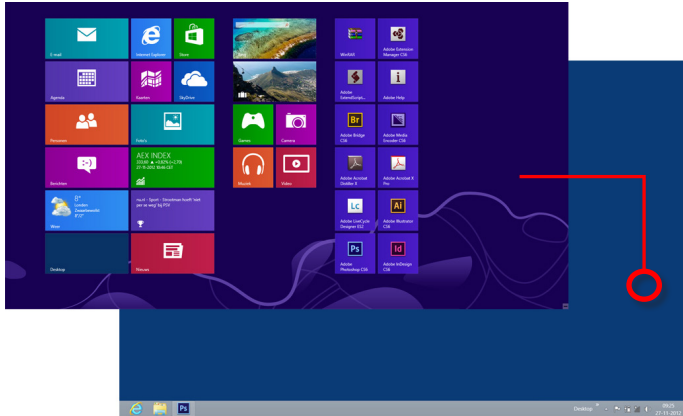

Wireless profile installation

Step 1

Go from the Start Screen to the Desktop.



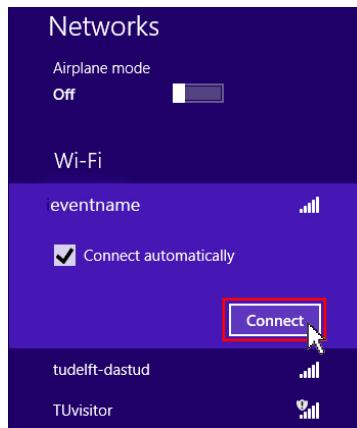
Step 2

Click the wireless network icon in your system tray



Step 3

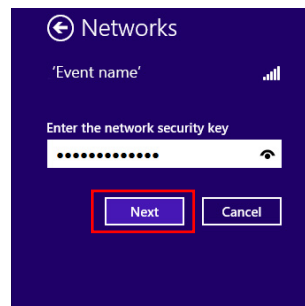
Click on **"eventname"** (name can differ with each event, if uncertain contact the event organisation). Then click Connect. A authentication dialog will appear.



Step 4

A **Password** or **WEP key** will be provided by the organisation of the event.

Click Next. A certificate dialog will appear.



Step 5

In a few seconds **"eventname"** is connected.
