

## Faculty of Aerospace and Engineering

The TU Delft Executive Board announced a temporary measure for a more lenient Bachelor/Master transition to help students cope with the corona virus measures: the 'Zachte Knip'. This measure was also installed last year, but please note that this measure can only be used once. In addition to this general measure that applies to all TU Delft students, Master programmes can add specific regulations.

In this announcement we list all regulations (TU Delft general and Aerospace Engineering specific) that apply for Bachelor and Pre-Master students who are enrolled in 2020 – 2021 at TU Delft and who wish to start in one of the MSc tracks at Aerospace Engineering in 2021 - 2022.

### **For Bachelor students**

Bachelor students may enrol in and take examinations in courses in the MSc Aerospace Engineering in the academic year 2021-2022 when:

- (TU Delft general) They have a deficit of no more than 15 EC in their Bachelor examination programme on 31 August 2021. The Zachte Knip does not apply after this date, e.g. to use this measure to enrol during the academic year. You must meet the requirements before 31 August 2021 ( results of examinations of quarter 5 included). If you meet the requirements after 31 August 2021 (=results as of Q1 2021-2022), it will not be possible to register for the Master programme.
- (AE specific) They have successfully completed the Design Synthesis Exercise, or similar bachelor graduation project/thesis for other TU Delft students.

This option to enrol in Master courses without having fully completed a Bachelor programme expires on 31 August 2022.

### **For Pre-Master students**

Pre-Master students may enrol in and take examinations in courses in the MSc Aerospace Engineering in the academic year 2021 – 2022 when:

- (TU Delft general) They have a deficit of no more than 15 EC in their Pre-Master's programme on 31 August 2021. The Zachte Knip does not apply after this date, e.g. to use this measure to enrol during the academic year. You must meet the requirements before 31 August 2021 ( results of examinations of quarter 5 included). If you meet the requirements after 31 August 2021 (=results as of Q1 2021-2022), it will not be possible to register for the Master programme.

The option to enrol in Master courses without having fully completed the Pre-Master programme expires on 31 August 2022.

### **Students that have used the Zachte Knip for 2020-2021**

The option to enrol in Master courses without having fully completed the Pre-Master programme expires on 31 August 2021. You cannot use the 'Zachte Knip' to continue with your Master courses after this date, if you have not yet successfully completed your Bachelor programme.

**Registration of obtained results**

For both Bachelor students and Pre-Master students the results they will obtain for Master courses will be registered for the Master examination programme once they will have formally completed the Bachelor or bridging programme.

**Continue with a Master at another faculty or university?**

Students who are planning to switch to another faculty or university for their MSc programme are advised to inform themselves about any specific requirements that apply there.
