Call for Bioengineering Workshop Proposals >> open call

Programme

TU Delft Bioengineering Institute strengthens the campus-wide collaboration of principal investigators who work on engineering solutions in, with and for biology. Examples of bioengineering research include bacteria engineered to produce chemicals or used for water treatment, new medical imaging technology and biomarkers for improved patient treatment. To support this mission, BEI facilitates meetings or workshops bringing together colleagues inside and outside Delft on bioengineering topics.

Type of support

BEI will take care of all the practical and financial support needed to help realize an attractive and effective workshop. The format is free, ranging from an online Teams meeting to half-day or one-day in-person meetings. The overall goal of the meetings is to improve the network of researchers interested in the proposed bioengineering topic at TU Delft, and to connect with external players in that field.

How do I apply?

You can apply for organizing a Bioengineering Workshop by sending an email to N.vanBemmel@tudelft.nl with a short plan, stating:

1. Your topic;
2. Why it's important to organize a workshop about this topic now;
3. The format/rough programme you have in mind;
4. The date you are aiming at;
5. Optional: names and affiliations of people you already know who might be interested in joining or co-organizing the workshop with you.

Assessment

During the first (online) board meeting upon receiving a proposal, the BEI Steering Committee will decide whether it will be supported. The Steering Committee reserves the right to have this selection fit strategic aims, such as diversity in topics.
